Bennie Stephen Johnson, more formally known as Dr. Ben Johnson (MD, NMD, DO), born November 11, 1950 to Finley and Willa Davis Johnson of Rossville, passed January 19, 2019. He was an author, influential speaker, helicopter pilot, avid hunter, outdoorsman, believer in Christ, and beloved father and friend. He practiced medicine in Colorado, Georgia, and California, dedicating his entire life to helping people, nurturing, treating, and serving the health and wellbeing of individuals from all around the world. He was predeceased by his father. He is survived by his mother, his brother Dan Johnson, sister Ann Morgan, seven children, Jeremiah, Bryan, Phillip, Lorena, Brooke, Andrew, and Michelle, his former wife Martha Johnson, 16 grandchildren, and a host of beloved in-laws and friends. The Funeral service will be held at 1:00 pm on Monday, January 28, 2019 at Calvary Chapel, with Pastor Robert Kosch officiating. Interment will be private for the family at Chattanooga National Cemetery.
