She was lifetime resident of North Georgia and member of North Whitfield Missionary Baptist Church. Johnnie Sue loved her Savior, her family, her friends and of course, her music. She always loved to share her talents with others, playing and singing. Johnnie Sue was actively involved with a number of organizations including the Truck Stop Ministries, Share America Foundation, Boynton Lions Club, and countless churches and benefits. Johnnie Sue has performed at numerous venues and has performed with countless acts including Con Hunley, Billy Joe Royal, Earl Thomas Conley, John Anderson, Ronnie McDowell, David Allen Coe, Waylon Jennings, Gene Watson, Garth Brooks, Roger Allen Wade, Travis Tritt, and Julio Igelesis. She was a member of the Atlanta Society of Entertainers, an inductee into the Atlanta Country Music Hall of Fame and the Library of Congress while receiving many other awards and recognitions during her life. Johnnie Sue was known for her larger than life personality and faith in God. There was only one “Johnnie Sue” and if you ever met her you will never forget her sense of humor and her addictive personality.
