Aileen Tucker, age 103, resident of Ringgold, Georgia, went to be with her Lord and Savior on Thursday, May 1, 2025.

Mrs. Tucker, daughter of the late Rufus Doyle Hill and Beatrix Osborne Hill, was born May 30, 1921 in Dalton, Georgia.
