Alma Pauline "Polly" (Buckner) Fisher, 91, of Chickamauga, GA., went home to be with the Lord on December 13, 2015. She was a lifelong resident of the Chattanooga and North Georgia area and was a member of the First Church of The Nazarene, where she had played the violin in the church orchestra along with her three children. The two sons each had god given gifts as musicians, which was encouraged to the fullest by their mother. Polly began working in the optical profession at age 18 and continued as an optician until she opened her own optical practice at age 63. She and her daughter Gloria worked together until the age of 90 when Polly had to retire due to health issues. Otherwise, we are sure she would have continued with the profession she enjoyed very much. Polly grew up as a country girl, riding horses, hauling hay and keeping up with her daddy on the farm. Gardening, canning, sewing, doll collecting, estate and yard sales and accomplishing any venture she chose to try.
