Amos Joseph Morgan, Jr. age 91, resident of Ringgold, Georgia, passed away on Sunday, March 23, 2025 at his residence.

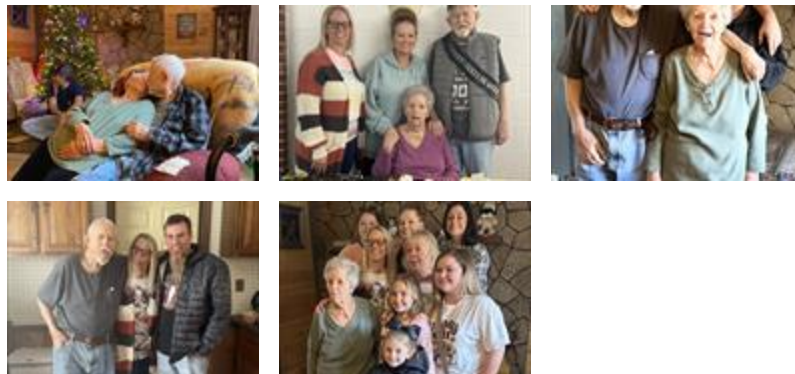

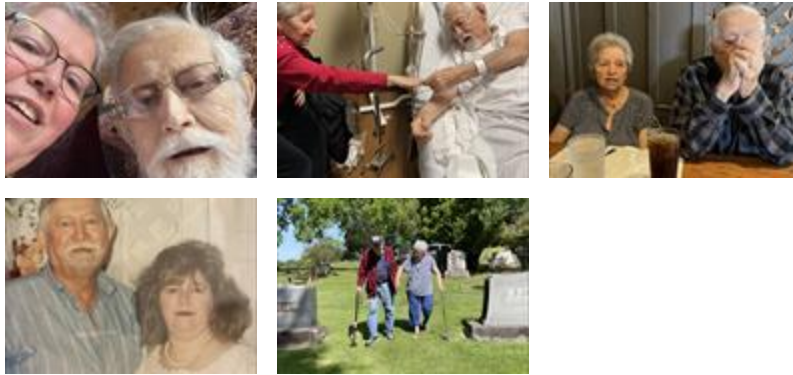

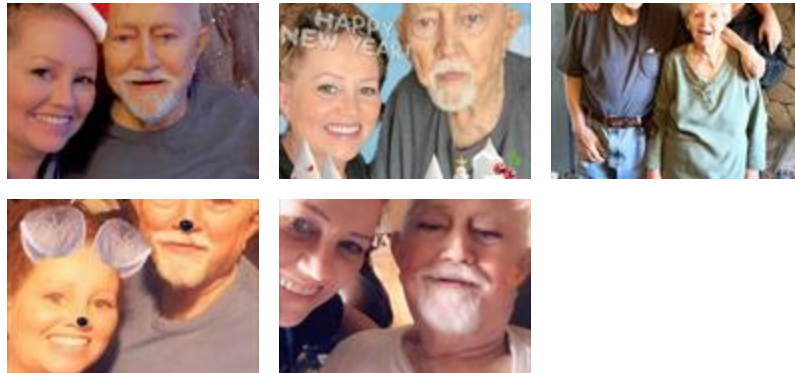
