February 10, 1948 - March 26, 2024

Bobby “Bubba” Dale Persinger, age 76, of Rossville, Georgia, passed away Tuesday, March 26, 2024, at his residence. He was born in Chattanooga, Tennessee, to the late Henry James and Pearl Lee Crumley Persinger. He was a graduate of Rossville High School – Class of 1966. Bubba served his country in the United States Marine Corps, where he earned the rank of Lance Corporal during the Vietnam War. Bubba was very well known and loved in northwest Georgia, where he had worked in law enforcement for thirty-eight years for the Catoosa County Sheriff’s Office. He enjoyed serving the public, and you could always count on a big smile and a hearty laugh when he was around. He was a member of Beacon Baptist Church. Along with his parents, he is preceded in death by his wife of fifty-one years, Jimmie Ann Simpson Persinger, sister Catherine Seiler, brothers Roy E. “Buster” Carroll, Harl Patric “Pat” Napier, Richard “Rick” Oden Napier and Donny Riebe.
