Brian "Pac-Man" Martin, age 52, resident of East Ridge, Tennessee, passed away on Sunday, February 4, 2024 at Parkridge East Hospital.

Brian, son of Milton Tracey Martin and Margaret "Ann" Goodlet Martin, was born November 22, 1971 in Gadsden, Alabama. He was employed with Avery Transport and had been a truck driver for over 20 years. Brian owned and rode Harley Davidson motorcycles. He rode with his brothers on Toy Runs and supported many of the charitable runs. Brian was a faithful member of Forsaken MC (Motorcycle Club) for the past 14 years, with fellow members stating he was "a brother to many."
