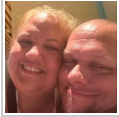

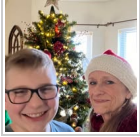

“ I am so sorry for your loss. I was blessed to work with Keith at Signal Centers and at Apison Elementary for several years. He was a handsome, bright and funny boy. I would like to share a memory from his pre-school days at Signal. Dad may remember. I wanted to teach Keith how to drive a power wheelchair to give him more independence. He was practicing in the "gym" area of the school before all the interior renovations were done. I walked backward in front of him, talking and having him push the joystick toward me as we circled the room. I misjudged where I was, still walking backward, tripped on a floor mat and fell on my back. All I could see was Keith laughing manically at me as he drove straight for me! As I rolled out of the way before he flattened me with the 200 lb wheelchair, I realized his dad was up in the hallway cracking up as well. No sympathy for the physical therapist scrambling about on the floor!

I know the grief must be overwhelming, but know he was cherished and loved by many. God has called him home and the dis-abilities are now abilities. The wheelchair, AFO's hand splints... all of his earthly bindings are gone and a thing of the past. You will live on in our hearts and minds, Keith. Love to you and all your family and friends.
