

Charles "Pete" Dickerson

July 7, 1937 - September 7, 2017

Charles "Pete" Dickerson, 80, of Guild, TN. passed away Thursday, September 7, 2017 in his home surrounded by his family. He was an avid bass fisherman and a member of the American Legion. He was a father of five, Pawpaw to four, and "the cool Uncle" to many nieces and nephews. He was born in Long Island, AL. and lived as an adult in Chattanooga and Guild, TN.

Pete served his country and community his entire life. He served in the US Army from 1956-1968 (SGT E5). While in the Army, he sang and played guitar in a band in Germany for two of those years with his fellow military brothers. He retired from the Chattanooga Police Department (1968-1983) where he received officer of the year in 1973, was the city's first to train from the police force as a first responder with EMT training, and one of the first "Sharpshooters" in the police academy.

After retiring from the police department, he went on to work as a Chattanooga bondsman for several years before going on to work for Hamilton County Corrections where he soon became the county's first felony probation officer. He retired from the county in 2004.

Pete was a loving Daddy, devoted friend, and was loved and respected by many people in Chattanooga.

He was preceded in death by his father and mother, David and Sarah Lawson Dickerson; brother Carl Dickerson; two sisters, Opal Hardin and Inez Goodwin.

He is survived by his children, Lacy Maselle, PJ Dickerson, Debbie Evans, Charles "Dickie" Dickerson and Chuck Clark; loving companion, Cindy Thompson; four grandchildren; one great grandchild.

Memorial service with honors will be held 2:30 P.M. Wednesday, September 27, 2017 at the Chattanooga National Cemetery.

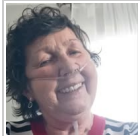
