Charles "Chuck" Joseph Askew, Sr., age 47 passed away on Sunday, October 6, 2013, surrounded by his family. He was a lifelong resident of Chickamauga and a member of The First Baptist Church of Chickamauga. He was a graduate of Gordon Lee High School class of 1985, a member of Phi Chi fraternity, at Young Harris College, and was an avid University of Georgia Football Fan. He had been employed by Walker County Government for the past 13 yrs. and was the owner/operator of Askew Metal Roofing Company.

Chuck was preceded in death by his mother, Regina Jane Raines Askew.

He is survived by his wife, of 11 yrs, Rena Askew; father, William "Bill" Askew; children, Joey Askew of Chickamauga, Emily Askew of Chickamauga, Lindsay Wiles of Chickamauga, and Jessica (Kody) Stewart of Macon; brothers, William "Mark" (Jane) Askew III and David Pender(Melinda) Askew, Sr. both of Chickamauga; nieces and nephews, Haley, William, Lloyd, and Penn.
