Dean Arnold Wells, age 65 of Rock Spring, passed away on Tuesday, June 18, 2013. Dean had recently moved back to the North Georgia Area from Lake Park, GA and had moved his membership from First Baptist Church of Lake Park to Oakwood Baptist Church, Chickamauga.
