Dimple Marie Plemons Potter, age 91 of Ringgold, passed away on Saturday, October 25, 2014.

She was born in Dalton to the late Bill and Ollie Plemons, and has been a resident of Ringgold for the past 80 yrs. She was a member of Ringgold First Baptist Church, taking part in several choirs, The Mary Crawford Circle, and active in the Senior Adult Group.
