Faye Jordan, age 93, went home to be with her Lord and Savior on Thursday, July 10, 2025.

Mrs. Jordan, daughter of the late Edward Clyde Barnes and Caroline Louise Tinker Barnes, was born August 8, 1931 in Chattanooga, Tennessee. She was a long-time member of Northside Presbyterian Church in Chattanooga where she was actively involved. Mrs. Jordan was a lifelong nurse and caregiver. She enjoyed working in her flower garden (particularly known for her talent of creating cottage gardens). Mrs. Jordan enjoyed traveling with her family.
