Frank was born and raised in Agat, Guam and resided in several places across the United States while serving in the United States Army and Air National Guard. Since 1970, Frank has resided in Ringgold and was a faithful member and deacon of Anchor of Hope Baptist Church.

Frank had a servants heart that he continually used to glorify the Lord and minister to others. He served on many mission trips to Mexico as well as Nicaragua, volunteered and assisted missionaries that visited Anchor of Hope, and for over 25 years he enjoyed cooking for a prayer breakfast held at Anchor of Hope every month.
