Jack Houston Haskin, 87 of Chickamauga, went home to be with his Lord and Savior on Monday, February 8, 2016. He was born in Charlotte, NC to the late Carl E. & Ruth Haskin, but had lived in the North Georgia area since 1973 and was a member and Grand Deacon of Bethlehem Baptist Church in Chickamauga. He retired from the United States Air Force after 24 years of dedicated service and was a Combat Veteran during the Korean conflict, the Vietnam War and multiple interventions.
