



## Jerry Winston Stansberry Sr.

On October 28, 2015, Jerry Winston Stansberry Sr., 86, went to be with the Lord. He died peacefully, surrounded by his family.

He graduated from Concord High School in Oregon. He enlisted in the US Navy and was one of the “greatest generation,” serving aboard the USS Missouri and the USS Boxer during WWII. He was honorably discharged in 1948. He moved during the depression. He managed a flax plant in Oregon and a plantation in California. He settled in Rock Spring, GA. He retired from Combustion Engineering. He was a deacon of Rock Spring Baptist Church and the treasurer for more than 50 years.

Jerry is preceded in death by his loving wife of 57 years, Delcie I. Stansberry; father, Arvil Stansberry and his mother, Velda Carter Stansberry.

He is survived by 1 son & 3 daughters; Jerry W. (Sheila) Stansberry Jr. of Noble, GA, Velda (LeRoy) Bradley of Chickamauga, GA, Marie Peterson of Rossville, GA, Trudy (Douglas) Barker of Rome, GA. He leaves behind 9 grandchildren, 17 great grandchildren, and 3 great-great grandchildren.
