He was a happy baby and brought joy to all who knew him. A short three years later, in 2017, his little sister Valynn was born, completing their family. Kale loved being a big brother to Valynn. They played together, dressed up together, fussed with each other, and loved each other as only siblings can. Kale loved his family, his friends, his pets (especially his cat Jasper), and above all, he loved the Lord. Kale was smart, creative, quick-witted, and had a kind, loving, giving heart! He loved all things crafty and especially loved creating beautiful gifts to give to others. Kale was currently a 2nd-grade student at North Lafayette Elementary School.

Kale was diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia (ALL) in October 2018. After countless treatments, his cancer returned for the first time in March 2022, the second time in April 2023, and returned for the final time in January 2024. Kale received cancer treatments at Children's Hospital at Erlanger and Children's Healthcare of Atlanta. Kale was so loved by his Chattanooga doctors, nurses, social workers, child life, and other care team members. He was a joy to know and to care for. His strength and courage during his battle was such an inspiration to all who followed his story. Countless lives have forever been touched.

After bravely fighting for nearly six years, sweet Kale Kale passed away

peacefully on March 16, 2024, surrounded by his family and friends. Kale is now cancer-free, fully healed, and in the arms of Jesus.
