Larry Parkinson Fleming Sr., 68, of Ringgold, Georgia went home to be with his Lord and Savior Thursday December 10, 2015. A lifelong resident of the North Georgia area, he was a member of Chattanooga Valley Baptist Church. Larry was a 1965 graduate of Rossville High School and received his Bachelor's degree from Carson Newman in 1969. He coached football and track for 46 years in Whitfield, Catoosa, Walker and Hamilton Counties. He also served as Youth Minister in several North Georgia area Churches. He is preceded in death by his parents, Roy P. and Mary Louise Dunn Fleming. Larry is survived by his loving wife of 48 years, Deborah Doughty Fleming of Ringgold, GA.; mother-in-law, Billie J. “ Coach Fleming was my track coach at Rossville High for four years. He loved his job and his athletes, and he was a man of amazing integrity. After my junior year, when I had worked very hard and made great progress as a middle distance runner, I went to Coach Fleming as an angry, tearful boy who was upset that I had not been given the award for most dedicated track athlete that year. Rather than scolding me for being so self-centered (which I surely was) Coach Fleming calmly admitted to me that he had made a mistake in not giving me this award (which he had not given to anyone at all that year).

I was amazed that he was so humble and so caring. The next year at the athletic awards banquet, Coach Fleming announced to a room full of people that he had made a mistake in not giving me this award my junior year, and he awarded me two plaques, one for the most dedicated runner of 1978 and one for the most dedicated runner of 1979. I have never won an award that I cherish so much. It tells me that he respected me enough to fess up to a small oversight -- because he cared about me and knew how important it was to me. This said a lot more about Coach Fleming's heart and his integrity than it said about my dedication as an athlete.

I will truly miss his crazy, irreverent sense of humor, his love of sports, his love of people, and his belief in the love of God and the power of forgiveness.

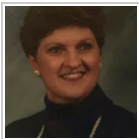
