Lynn E. Brock, 72, passed away at his home on Wednesday, January 2, 2019. He was born August 10, 1946 in Chickamauga, Georgia and had resided there all his life. He was the son of Luetta Warren and Roy Edgar Brock. Lynn was a devoted father, granddad, uncle, brother-in-law and friend.
