



Malcolm Clayton Crowder

October 3, 1932 - April 5, 2017

Malcolm Clayton Crowder, age 84 of Chickamauga, went home to be with his Lord on Wednesday, April 5, 2017. He was a lifelong resident of Chickamauga, was a longtime member of Elizabeth Lee United Methodist Church and has been attending Friendship Primitive Baptist Church in recent years. Malcolm served his country in the U.S. Army during the Korean War and was the owner/operator of Crowder Supply in Chickamauga, along with his brother for over 37 yrs.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Chester Lee & Bessie Alice Fitts Crowder; his sister, Mattie Lowe Taylor; and grandson, Robert Clayton Clemons.

Malcolm is survived by his loving wife, of 63 yrs., Juanita Childers Crowder; children, Laura Ann (Dick) Clemons and Clay Malcolm (Denise) Crowder; brother, Chester Ray Crowder; 5 grandchildren; 7 great grandchildren; and several nieces & nephews.

The funeral service will be held at 3:00 pm on Friday, April 7, 2017 in the funeral home chapel, with Elder Wayne Peters officiating.
