March 13, 1921 - November 2, 2016

Mamie Arene Crowder Newton, 95, died peacefully Wednesday November 2, 2016 at her home in Ringgold, Georgia. Although she grew up in Chattanooga, she has been a resident of Georgia for most of her life, having lived in Rossville and Ft. Oglethorpe prior to moving to Ringgold.

Miss Mamie, as she was known, was the oldest member of Community Baptist Church in Rock Spring, Georgia. She was the matriarch and prayer warrior and greatly loved by the members. She and her husband, Milton, were founding members of Memorial Baptist Tabernacle where she taught the ladies Bible class for 46 years. For many years she and her father operated a grocery store in Rossville.
