



## Marjorie Ann Henry Anderson

October 4, 1924 - August 15, 2022

Marjorie Ann Henry Anderson, age 97 of Chickamauga, went home to be with the Lord on Monday, August 15, 2022. She was born to the late Joseph Eubanks Henry and Gladys Irene Carlock Henry in Chickamauga, raised in Rock Spring, lived most of her life in Chickamauga and was a member of Elizabeth Lee United Methodist Church, where she was a long time member of the Katie Sue Bowen Group. Marjorie worked for the Chickamauga Telephone Co. and the City of Chickamauga, but also had the honor of registering young men into the U.S. Army for WWII while working for the US Government in Fort Oglethorpe.
