Mark had lived in the North Georgia & Chattanooga areas for most of his life and was a faithful member of The Rossville Church of God of Prophecy and its ministries. Because of Diana, i was encouraged to go to college at UTC. She made teaching seem like a possibility for me. I will always be grateful for her encouragement.

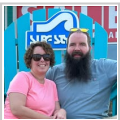

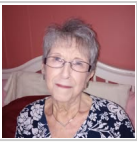
