



Marlin Kenneth Paulson

Marlin Kenneth Paulson, age 88, resident of Fort Oglethorpe, Georgia, went to be with his Lord and Savior on February 18, 2024. Mr. Paulson, son of the late Carl Paulson and Geraldine Welge Paulson, was born July 1, 1935 in Gruver, Iowa. He was a veteran of the U.S. military serving his country honorably in the U.S. Army from 1954 to 1956. Mr. Paulson worked at State Farm for over 36 years, retiring as a Superintendent, Claims Adjustor. He was a member of First Baptist Church of Fort Oglethorpe and served as part of Constructors for Christ. Mr. Paulson was also involved heavily in the local community, serving as a member of Kawanis; volunteered at Hospice of Chattanooga, and served on the board for MS. He was known as an avid walker, and even ran a marathon. Mr. Paulson was a man who enjoyed helping others with home projects, particularly building handicap ramps. He enjoyed working in the yard, and traveling where he and his wife through the years traveled to all 50 states. While at home, he enjoyed watching Atlanta Braves baseball, but more importantly he looked forward to spending quality time with his family. The family remembers him as a giving man, serving others, and never wanted attention towards himself.

Besides his parents, he was preceded in death by a sister, JoAnne Stark. Mr. Paulson is survived by his wife of 66 years, Mary Paulson of Fort Oglethorpe, Georgia; two sons, Michael Paulson and his wife Drenda of Buford, Georgia and Mark Paulson and his wife Marly of Chattanooga, Tennessee; two sisters, Lavon Peton and Sheryl Marr; five grandchildren, Lindsey McDaniel and her

husband Travis, Matthew Paulson and his wife Brennan, Kelly Paulson, Alana Long and her husband Jordan, and Jack Paulson; six great-grandchildren; many other relatives and friends.
