Marshall Ray Taylor, 86, passed away on Friday, March 13, 2015 at his residence.

He was a lifelong resident of Ringgold and was a lifelong member of Salem Baptist Church. He served as deacon since 1967 and taught the senior adult class for many years. He served on Salem Cemetery committee as treasurer and worked to get perpetual care through the Georgia Baptist Foundation. Marshall was a graduate of Ringgold High School class of 1945. He retired from Dupont, Chattanooga, after 40 years of service. He was a member of the senior bowling league team (Ringgold Trio).
