



Mary Darlene Quails

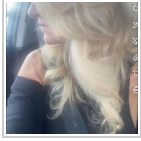
January 23, 1962 - July 18, 2016

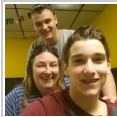

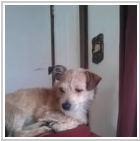
