Michael “Mike” Terry Patrick age 71, of Fort Oglethorpe, Georgia went home to be with The Lord Sunday - January 22, 2023. He was born in Chattanooga, Tennessee to the late Joel Elmore and Monie Thelma “Terry” Davis Patrick. Mike graduated from Lakeview High School – Class of 1969. During high school he served as the manager of the football and basketball teams, where everyone knew him as “Manager Mike.” Mike was very patriotic and served the Fort Oglethorpe community in many ways, such as T-Ball Commissioner and concessions manager at the Post Recreation Association for many years. He served as a Post Volunteer Fire Fighter since 1969 and earned the rank of Assistant Fire Chief. He was an ordained Deacon where he served at Peavine Baptist Church and Cedar Hill Baptist Church. Mike enjoyed worshipping his Savior through serving others as a deacon and through the visitation team, and singing in the choir and on the Praise Team at Peavine Baptist Church. Mike worked at Winkler Sign Company, T.V.A. Fire Ops at Sequoyah Nuclear Plant and was a Journeyman with the I.B.E.W. Local #175, and served as Clerk of Courts for The City of Fort Oglethorpe from 1996 to 2016. Mike loved The Lord, his family and serving his community.
