Patty Coppinger Price, 46, of Chickamauga, passed away Sunday, July 13, 2014. She had lived in the Chickamauga area for most of her life and was of the Baptist faith. She graduated from Rossville High School Class of 86' and then attended Northwestern Technical College for more than 3 years. She was a member of the Chickamauga Recreation Association since 1993 and coached her girls and many others in softball until 2010.
