Paul "Urffer" Ballard Lusk, Jr., age 66 of Ft. Oglethorpe, passed away on Thursday, March 27, 2014. He was a lifelong resident of North Georgia and was of the Christian Faith. Paul served his country in the U.S. Army during the Vietnam War, where he received the Vietnam Campaign Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, and the National Defense Service Medal. He retired from Tuftco Corp. in 2008 after 18 yrs. of employment. Paul was a loving husband, father, grandfather and brother, who will be greatly missed.
