



Mr. Ray E. Beeler

March 11, 1927 - March 8, 2024

Ray E. Beeler age 96, of Tunnel Hill, Georgia, passed away at his home Friday, March 8, 2024. He was born in Albany, Alabama to the late James Garfield and Mary Jane Morgan Beeler. He had resided most of his life in the Chattanooga and northwest Georgia areas. In the late 1940s, while working for Addressograph-Multigraph, Ray realized the potential market for refurbished office equipment. From his home garage in Brainerd, he began refurbishing and selling used office equipment. In early 1954, he and his wife, Elizabeth, founded Beeler Impression, a company that he continued to build over the next 70 years, working every business day even to his current age of 96. When he wasn't working he enjoyed hunting, spending time outdoors and raising and training rottweilers. Along with his parents and two brothers, Rex and Roy, he is preceded in death by wife, Elizabeth Ann Cordell Beeler. He is survived by his daughters Jan (Mike) Hartness of Chattanooga, TN and Alissa Beeler of Nashville, TN; grandsons Dodd (Kelley) Hartness and Jeb (Jill) Hartness; four great-grandchildren and two great-great-grandchildren all of Chattanooga.
