Ray O. Plaster born Nov.24, 1940, left this earth on Friday, October 28, 2022. He was born in Meigs County, Tennessee, and later moved to McMinn County and Graduated from McMinn County High School in 1959, Joined US Air Force and after being honorably discharged from service he went to work for the Georgia Department of Natural Resources as the first area manager of Oaky Woods Wildlife Management area in Houston County, Georgia. He transferred to law enforcement as a game warden and moved to Walker County in 1970. He loved his job and always said he got paid for doing what he loved.
