September 13, 1947 - February 10, 2016

Rebecca Ann Claiborne Farr, 68, left this world behind Wednesday, February 10, 2016 at 10:15 a.m. In life, she walked in the strength of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and was welcomed home by our heavenly Father.

Becky was born September 13, 1947 in Chattanooga, grew up in East Ridge and graduated from East Ridge High School. She married George Farr November 22, 1969, taking up residence in Chickamauga, where she became active in the religious and civic life of the community.

Exceptionally bright, energetic and loyal, Becky followed various lines of work, at which she never failed to measure up to the highest standards. She and her husband eventually established Farr's Refinishing. A perfectionist, Becky's skills in furniture restoration were in great demand. The excellence of her work could be seen in each piece she worked on, resulting in the efforts of her labors standing out above others.

The first thing everyone noticed about Becky was her dazzling smile. She loved the Lord with all her heart and it cast an amazing light on everything she did. She was always ready to lend a helping hand; no one ever called on her for assistance who didn't receive, without hesitation, the best she had to give. It was one of her special gifts. “Others,” because that was, without doubt, her motto in life.

Becky faithfully attended church all of her life and enjoyed an unwavering relationship with her church families. She joined Oakwood Baptist Church in 2012. She was full of kindness, and everyone knew her heart belonged to God. Becky enjoyed her Sunday School class and Bible studies. Additionally, she quickly volunteered, serving as Greeter on Sunday mornings, and helping with many of the organized activities.

She was a member of Chickamauga Presbyterian Church from 1978 – 2012, during which time Becky committed herself to an active participation in God’s kingdom, through the work of the church. She was an ordained Elder, served as Worship Committee Chairperson 7 years, and was active in Women of the Church Auxiliary, serving in various positions, including President and Secretary. She sang in the choir for about 32 years, and also served as Liturgist. She was the first official church secretary, serving under Rev. Bill Mills from October 1, 1978 – August 1, 1980.

Becky was preceded in death by her parents, Ollie and Ruth Claiborne, her beloved son, Matthew (Matt) Farr, and her nephew, Rick McDowell.

Those left to cherish her memory include her husband, George W. Farr; granddaughters, Megan and Bailey Farr; brother, Glen (Helen) Claiborne of Ocala, Florida; sister, Martha McDowell of Chickamauga; several nieces and nephews, and devoted friend, Janey Westbrook.
