Renzy Stewart age 89, of Snellville, GA – formerly of Chickamauga, GA passed away Saturday - July 25, 2015.

He was born on August 23, 1925 in Winchester, TN to the late Allen Lloyd and Lillie Mae Marshall Stewart. He had lived in the Atlanta area for over 30 years and was a former resident of the Chattanooga and North Georgia areas for most of his life. He was of the Christian faith and proudly served his country in the U.S. Navy during World War II. While in the Navy he served on the USS Martin H. Ray in the Atlantic, USS Martin and USS Wolf in the Pacific. He served from October 29, 1943 until March 22, 1946, at the time of his separation he was Seaman Second Class and received the American Theatre Medal, European-African Mid-East Medal, Victory Medal and Asiatic-Pacific Medal. He retired from Lockheed Martin after thirty years of employment. He enjoyed watching old classic movies, gardening, being outdoors, camping, fishing, hunting deer, rabbits, squirrels and turkey.

Along with his parents, he is preceded in death by his beloved wife of sixty six years: Vivilene Marie Duggan Stewart, siblings: Edna Frazier, Dorothy Jones, Martha Stanley, Marshall, J.B. and Houston Stewart.

He is survived by his sisters: Mary Gerould of Pennsylvania, Elizabeth Taylor of East Ridge, TN, several nieces and nephews.

The family will receive friends Friday from 11:00 am – 1:00 pm prior to the service. Funeral services will be held at 1:00 p.m. Friday - July 31, 2015 in the chapel with Pastor Jim Hixson officiating. Burial will follow in the Chattanooga Veterans National Cemetery.
