



Mr. Robert Frankie Fowler

Robert "Frankie" Franklin Fowler, age 78 of Chickamauga, went home to be with his Lord, on Friday, December 28, 2012. He was a lifelong resident of Chickamauga and was of the Baptist Faith. Frankie served his country as a military Intelligence technician in the U.S. Air Force during the Korean War and 2 tours in the Vietnam War. He received the Bronze Star before retiring in 1972. Frankie also retired from Walker Co. as the Director of Civil Defense in 1992 after 20 yrs. He was a great and honorable man who will be missed greatly by his family.

Frankie was preceded in death by his parents, Robert Paskel and Beulah Mae Autry Fowler; son, Richard Fowler; sister, Lillie Mae Nibblett; and brother, Bob Fowler.
