February 23, 1919 - November 9, 2015

Robert Earl “Granddaddy” White age 96, of Rock Spring, GA went home to be with The Lord Monday morning – November 9, 2015. He was born in Holland, Georgia to the late Robert Alexander White and Fannie Mae Ratliff White. He had resided in Rock Spring, Georgia for the past sixty three years. He served his country during World War II in the U.S. Army where he was a Prisoner of War in a German camp for over eleven months. He received a Purple Heart and numerous other awards and medals. He retired from The State of Georgia where he worked for the Road Department for over thirty years. After retiring he worked for W.L. Wilson & Sons Funeral Home in Fort Oglethorpe for several years. He was a longtime active member of Center Grove Baptist Church where he served as Deacon and a member of the Men’s Literature Sunday School Class. He enjoyed camping and traveling as well as building various crafts. Along with his parents, he was preceded in death by two sisters and six brothers. He is survived by his wife of sixty five years Mrs. Fannie Ruth Parker White, their son: Robert Edward “Eddie” White, granddaughters: Amy White Perry all of Rock Spring, GA, Maranda White of Rossville, GA, great-grandchildren: Emma Sweeten, Robert Lane Perry, Elizabeth “Libby” Perry, sister: Nancy (Louis) Westbrook of Buford, GA, several nieces and nephews.
