Mr. Jack stuck to his principles and offered wisdom often. As I was driving back and forth to mortuary school in Atlanta for over a year I would stop by five nights a week to get gas. Every night I went in to pay (no credit card accepted at the pumps then) Mr. Jack would ask me how you doing in school buddy, I'd answer and he'd say "need a co-cola buddy?" get you one on me. He not only gave me ice cream and "co-colas" (as he would say) he instilled time. We live in a fast pace world where not many people have time or really care to ask "how you doing today buddy" I'm very thankful God gave me a buddy named Mr. Jack.

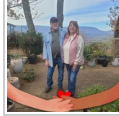

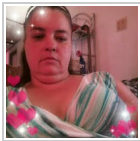
