Ronald "Ron" Lee Hamilton, 75, of Lookout Valley, Tennessee, went home to be with the Lord on April 27, 2019. Ronald was born in Whitwell, TN on March 12, 1944, in his grandmother's home to Newt and Marie Hamilton. He was the second oldest of six children.

Ronald was a hard worker from an early age. When he was a teenager, he worked on a dairy farm before and after school. He was a Vietnam War Army Veteran from 1966-1969, where he was stationed in Thailand and served as a mechanic. On the day he returned home from the service, he met the teenage girl who would become his wife 14 years later. He was a meat cutter for 17 years at Red Food Store and 20 years at Pruett's. In his retirement, he worked part-time as a sales associate for Ace Hardware of Lookout Valley. He was a loving husband, father, and friend to anyone who ever had the pleasure of meeting him.
