



Col. Ronald "Ronnie" Lee Bowman

June 17, 1953 - February 16, 2015

Colonel Ronald Lee Bowman age 61, of Rock Spring, GA passed away after a lengthy illness Monday – February 16, 2015 at his residence with his devoted wife Betty by his side.

Colonel Bowman, the son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Robert & Katherine (Kitty) Ballew Bowman, was born June 17, 1953 in Chattanooga, Tennessee. He was a 1970 graduate of Lakeview High School in Fort Oglethorpe, Georgia. He received his Bachelor of Science Degree in Criminal Justice Administration and his Master's Degree in Criminal Justice Systems from the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga. He is a graduate of the Federal Bureau of Investigations National Academy and in addition has received numerous awards and diplomas for law enforcement related training. Colonel Bowman was active in law enforcement since 1972 when he was employed by the Catoosa County Sheriff's Department as a dispatcher/jailer. From that position, he went on to become a patrolman for the Fort Oglethorpe Police Department, and in 1974 was employed as Georgia State Trooper. He was elected Sheriff of Catoosa County in 1986, and served in that capacity until Governor Zell Miller appointed him Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety. He was employed as Director of Hutcheson Medical Center EMS in Fort Oglethorpe, Georgia Fugitive Squad and retired from the United States Marshal Service. Colonel Bowman is a member of Tompkins Masonic Lodge F&AM #466 and an Alhambra Shriner. He is a member of the Peace Officers

Association of Georgia, the National Criminal Justice Honor Society and numerous other civic and professional organizations.

He is survived by his loving wife: Betty Smith Bowman of Rock Spring, GA, daughters: Angela Bowman of Fort Oglethorpe, GA, Amber (Joey) Swindle of Chickamauga, GA, Leah (Michael Lee) Sawyer of South Carolina, son: Chad (Christy) Akins of Chickamauga, GA, sister: Earlene (Alfred) Bailey of Ringgold, GA, brother: Robert "Bill" (Debbie) Bowman of Fort Oglethorpe, GA, eight grandchildren, one great-grandchild, several nieces and nephews.
