It doesn't bither me a bot

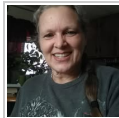

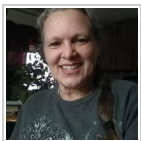

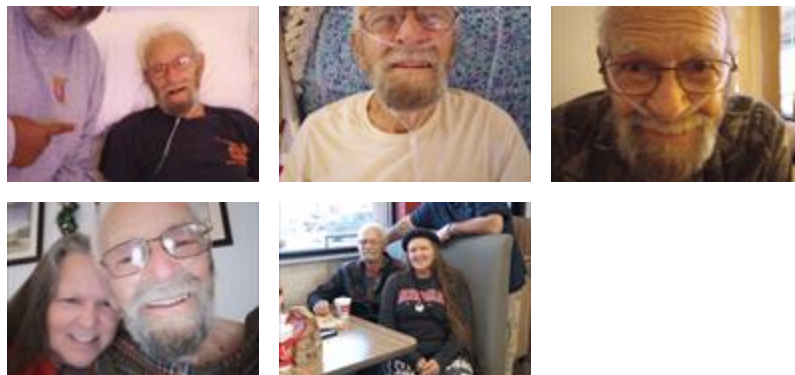
