Reverend Stephen H. Moore, age 65, went to be with his Lord and Savior on Tuesday, January 9, 2024. He was born to the late Evertie Edward Moore and Myrtle Joyce Gailey Moore, September 13, 1958, in Chattanooga, Tennessee. Reverend Moore was currently serving as pastor of Griffith Creek Community Church in Whitwell, Tennessee. During over 30 years of faithful ministry, he mentored young pastors and assisted ministries seeking leadership.

Reverend Moore loved people, loved to just visit people, and meet anyone's needs as much as possible. He sang in a pastor's quartet, loved playing guitar and singing in nursing homes, homeless shelters, and prison. He treasured the opportunity to sing with his four sons at church. Reverend Moore relished the time he had with his sons. Many would see him at ball games, never missing any event in which they participated. He played board games with family and friends and enjoyed building puzzles. He was an avid Kentucky Wildcat fan, and loved watching the Kentucky basketball team. He would also watch and support his son's favorite teams and would actually respond to them during the games.

The family remembers him as a dedicated Godly husband, father, and grandfather.

Reverend Moore is survived by his wife of 45 years, Connie Moore; four sons, Pastor Matthew Moore and his wife Amanda Ivy, Daniel Moore and his wife Shawna, Joshua Moore and his wife Jordan, and Nathanael Moore; one

sister, Lynn Moore-Turner and her husband Russell; two brothers, Lathan Moore and his wife Linda, and Lonnie Moore and his wife Gail; eight grandchildren, Jackson, Ava, Madalynn, Alex, Lincoln, Canaan, Grayson, and Kai; numerous nieces; nephews; other relatives and friends.

Funeral Services are scheduled at the Chapel of W. L. Wilson and Sons Funeral Home on Saturday, January 13, 2024, 3 p.m. with Pastor Matthew Moore officiating. The family will receive friends at the funeral home prior to the service on January 13, 2024 from 1-3 p.m. Private interment will be at Lakewood Cemetery South.

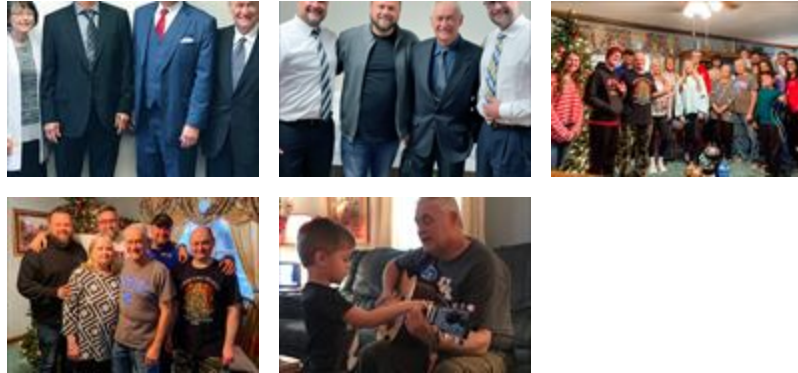
