



Col. Ted Dewayne Cash MD

October 10, 1938 - October 24, 2016

Col. Ted Dewayne Cash, MD, age 78 of Chickamauga, passed away on Monday, October 24, 2016. He was born in Haralson county, GA and has been a resident of Chickamauga most of his life. He attended Chickamauga Presbyterian Church, and served his country in the US Army National Guard as a physician from 1968 to 1990. He graduated from the University of GA with a Bachelor's degree in 1961. He was a graduate of the Medical College of Georgia where he received a doctorate degree in 1966. He started practicing medicine in Tallapoosa, GA, before moving to Lafayette for two years, then finishing his medical career in Chickamauga after 28 years in 2002.

Ted was preceded in death by his parents, Harold and Eula Agan Cash; sister, Betty Tuggle.

He is survived by his loving wife of 58 years, Myra Dennis Cash; Children, Andrea Cash Aaron, Dennis (Teresa) Cash, David (Lisa) Cash, and former son in law Jim Aaron; Brothers, B.L. 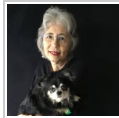
