



Timothy Eugene Kendrick

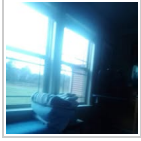
July 20, 1960 - March 16, 2020

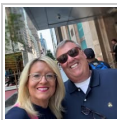

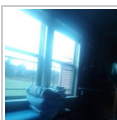

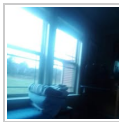
