



Tommy "Fuzzy" Clark

April 25, 1937 - June 4, 2018

Tommy "Fuzzy" Clark, 81, of Chickamauga passed June 4, 2018. He was born in Coulterville, TN, April 25, 1937, the son and only child of Alfred Lewis Clark and Chaina Irene Swafford Clark. Proud member of the 1954 Rossville High School Bulldogs State Champion football team. Served in US Marine Corps Reserve from 1955 to 1963. Retired with 43 years service as a journeyman wireman and continued 61 years of membership in IBEW Local 175. He was above all else a diehard Georgia Bulldogs fan.

Tommy was also preceded in death by his infant son, James Mark Clark.
