William "Bill" Riggs, 86, of Ringgold, passed away on August 13, 2025. A lifelong resident of Ringgold, Bill was a longtime member of East Ridge Church of Christ. He dedicated 35 years of service to Chattanooga Tractor & Equipment before retiring. He later joined Groome Transportation as a driver—a role he grew to genuinely enjoy—where he worked for another 17 years before retiring a second time.
