



## William B. Woods

October 10, 1925 - July 25, 2024

William B. (“Bill”) Woods, 98, died on July 25, 2024, after a fall at his home. Bill was born in Chattanooga on October 10, 1925, to Wiley O. Woods, Sr., and Mattie Whitehead Woods. He graduated from Central High School in 1943 and attended the University of Chattanooga until entering the Army Air Forces, where he was a radio operator on a B-17.

In 1948 Bill met Peggy Howard. A month later they married, cherishing each other for the next 69 years, until Peg’s death in 2018.

After Bill graduated from the McKenzie College of Law in 1952, he and Peg moved to Rossville, GA, where he worked for Georgia Land Title. In 1956 Bill and Lamar M. Christian opened Woods-Christian Title Agency.

In retirement Bill was a golfer, traveler, voracious reader, and Facebook raconteur. As a lifelong Democrat, he was an enthusiastic provocateur of Republicans. But he found his greatest joy in his grandchildren, Zack Woods and Liz Woods, both of Chattanooga, and his great-grandchildren, Kylie, Jaiden, and Korvin.

Bill was preceded in death by his brother, Wiley O. Woods, Jr., and sister, Barbara Woods Brown.

In addition to his grandchildren and great-grandchildren, he is survived by his daughter Terry Woods (Knoxville), son Mitch Woods and daughter-in-law Nancy Blalock Woods (Ft. Oglethorpe), sister Pat Woods Dobbins (John) (Canton, N.C.), cats Kermit and Twiggy, and numerous nieces and nephews.

A private graveside service will be held on Tuesday, July 30, 2024, at Chattanooga National Cemetery, the Rev. Stephen Overall officiating.

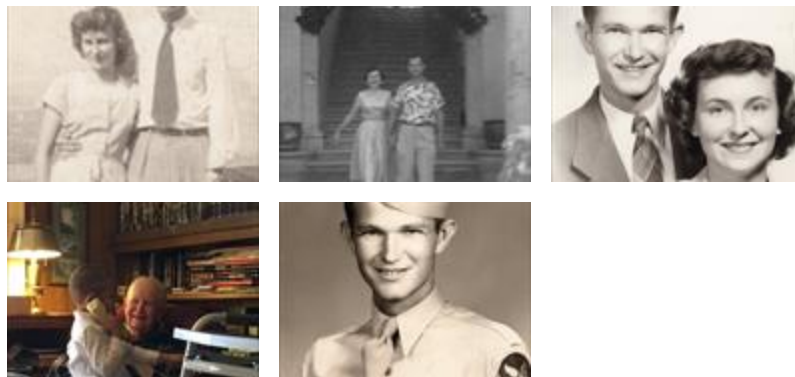
